The general objectives of T.B. Scott Free Library are:

- 1. To collect, preserve, and administer, in organized collections, books and other media promoting the self-development of individuals, whatever their stage of education and culture.
- 2. To serve the community as a center of reliable information.
- 3. To provide a broad variety of resources reflecting all points of view in today's complex society, so that inquiring minds may find available original, even unorthodox, ideas so necessary in a society dependent on the freedom of ideas and critical thinking for its survival and continued development.
- 4. To identify community needs, to provide programs of service to meet those needs, and to cooperate with other organizations, agencies and institutions providing similar programs and services.
- 5. To supplement the formal education programs of schools by supplying materials and services that cannot be adequately and conveniently provided by institutions of formal instruction.
- 6. To meet as closely as possible Wisconsin state standards for public library service.
